Dating back to 1776 this charming flint fronted cottage has been sympathetically updated to provide versatile accommodation and generous private garden.

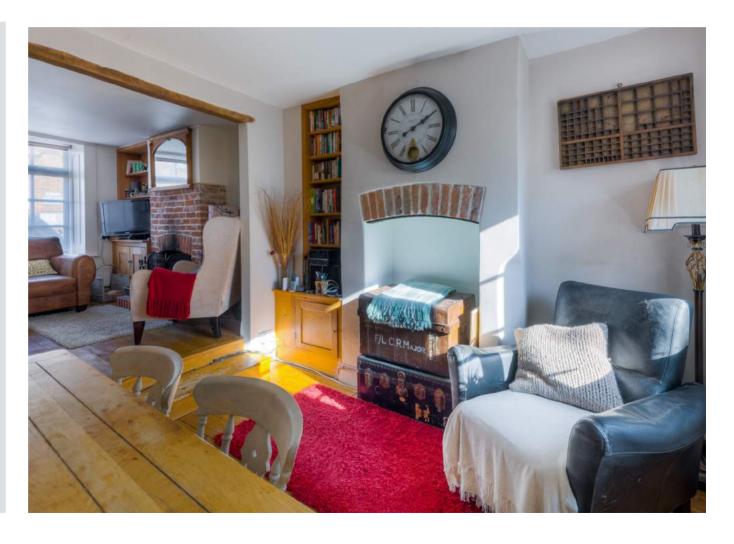

Description

Once inside, the ground floor comprises of an entrance hall which leads into a spacious sitting room with central feature fireplace and open plan dining room, also with a fireplace. From the dining room there are stairs rising to the first-floor landing and a door leading to the farmhouse style kitchen with vaulted ceiling. Adjoining the kitchen is a utility room and a ground floor cloakroom. Completing the ground floor is the garden room, which is located from the utility room. From here double doors lead to a partly decked South facing garden. The first floor comprises of the master bedroom and a spacious family bath and shower room. Occupying the entire second floor is the guest bedroom with a window overlooking the garden, large built-in wardrobes and eaves storage area. It is our opinion that due to the size of the guest bedroom an additional shower room could be created in the space serving as an en-suite, subject to all relevant consents. The rear garden is a particular feature, with a large decked area ideal for alfresco dining which leads to the remaining South facing, well-stocked cottage garden.

Location

The cathedral town of Arundel with its impressive Norman castle sits on the boundary of the South Downs National Park. Consistently considered as one of the finest towns in the country and made famous internationally for its antique dealerships. Once a thriving fishing town the public houses and fisherman's cottages have made way for traditional tearooms, boutiques and an eclectic mix of independent restaurants. Now well known for its numerous festivals throughout the year.

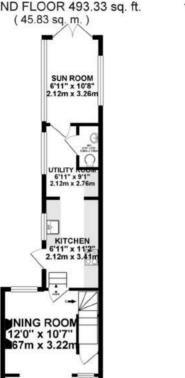
